### Add another HTTP Request sampler for attaching files to the ticket and configure it as follows:

- Protocol: your JIRA installation protocol, most likely https
- Host: your JIRA installation IP address or hostname •
- Method: POST •
- Path: /rest/api/2/issue/\${issue\_id}/attachments •
- Tick Use multipart/form-data for POST box •
- In the "File Upload" tab provide full or relative path to your file and its MIME type. Keep • "Parameter Name" value as file
