



RULES OF “TECH AND ARCHITECTURE QUIZ COMPETITION”

February-March 2021

Art. 1 Campaign organizer

The organizer of the campaign is R SYSTEMS COMPUTARIS EUROPE S.R.L., a company established and operating according to the laws of Romania, having its registered office in Bucharest, 5 Gheorghe Manu Street ground floor and 1st floor, registered at the Register of Companies under no. J40/9250/2001, Tax Identification Number RO14273248. The purpose of the contest is to promote the company.

This Regulation describes the conduct of the Campaign and is binding on all participants. Any modification of these Regulations by the Organizer will be published on the company's website. By participating in this campaign, the knowledge of the regulations and the consent of the Participant are presumed. The participants undertake to respect and comply with all the terms, conditions and provisions of this Regulation.

Art. 2 Duration and area of campaign carrying out

The contest will take place exclusively online, both during the event CodeCamp Romania 2021 on 24 – 25 of February 2021 and on the site of R Systems Computaris on the page: <https://www.eu.rsystems.com/tech-architecture-quiz-codecamp-2021-2/>, until the 23rd of March 2021, 18:00 EET.

Art. 3 Way of carrying out

Participants can register by completing, **in English**, the participation form available online on R Systems Computaris page, giving their consent regarding the collection of personal data and the rules of procedure.

Each participant fills in a form containing two open-ended technical questions, the identification data of the participants, the contest rules and the consent regarding the collection of personal data, terms and conditions.

Each participant will be assigned a sole registration number for the contest. All the answers received through the participation form will be evaluated and scored according to the relevance and correctness of the answers. The correct answers will be additionally scored for creativity and / or innovative solutions.

The winner will be announced on the contest page on March 26, 2021. Also, the winner will be contacted by email and / or phone, at the dates filled in the entry form.

The organizer does not assume any responsibility regarding the lack of accuracy of the data filled in by the contest participant in the registration form and which has as a consequence the impossibility of contacting by email or telephone in the event that the participant is designated the winner. In order to validate the prize, the winner is asked for the identification data filled in on the participation form, as well as a (scanned) copy of the identity document.

Art. 4 Participation right

Only individuals ("Participants") aged at least 18 years of age, residing exclusively in Romania, Republic of Moldova and Poland, can register to participate in the R Systems Computaris Quiz. The organizer's employees or their relatives in a direct line cannot participate in the Campaign Contests.

Art. 5 Prize of the campaign

The prize awarded in the contest, will be 1 (one) network attached storage, worth approximately 400 Eur. It is not possible to exchange the prize offered in the contest in cash. The prize not awarded, as a result of invalidation or inability to contact the winner, will remain the property of the Organizer. In this case, within 10 calendar days from the announcement of the winner, the Organizer may decide to award the prize to the next runner up (depending on the score obtained). The invalidated winner will be informed by email that, after his / her designation as winner, he / she has been invalidated, being indicated the reason that determined the invalidation. The validation and / or invalidation of the winners must be performed for each stage until the 15th of the current calendar month at the latest in which the drawing of the winners took place.

The Organizer is entitled to take all necessary measures in case of attempted system fraud, abuse or any other attempts that could affect the image of this Contest.

Art. 6 Taking possession of the prize

After completing the validation process of the winner, the Organizer will send the prize by courier or will hand it directly to the winner, at its headquarters on str. Gh. Manu no. 5, Sector 1, Bucharest.

Art. 7 Disputes

In case of potential disputes between the organizer and the participants in the Campaign, these will be settled amicably. If it is not possible to resolve the disputes amicably, the parties involved will submit the dispute for settlement to the competent Romanian courts.

Art. 8 Rules of Campaign

Art. 9 Charges and taxes



The Organizer undertakes to bear the tax due for the income consisting of the prizes obtained by the winners as a result of this Campaign, in accordance with the provisions of the Fiscal Code, any other obligations of a fiscal nature or of any other nature, in this connection, being in exclusive charge of the winners.

Art. 10 Complaints

Any complaint regarding the violation of these Regulations in the course of the contest must be sent to the Organizer at contact@eu.rsystems.com within 3 (three) days from the publication of the winners. The complaint will be analyzed by the Organizer within 14 days of receipt. The reply will be sent by a message sent to the e-mail address provided on the occasion of the complaint. The organizer does not assume responsibility for any disruption in the operation of telecommunications connections, servers, interfaces, web browsers and the Facebook platform.

Art. 11 Processing of Personal Data

By registering and participating in the Contest, the Participants declare that they agree with the provisions of these Regulations and agree that their personal data to enter the Organizer's database, to be processed and used by it for purposes such as: awarding the prize, recruitment. By registering and participating in the Contest, Participants declare that they agree to the processing of personal data for the above purposes and that such personal data are to be kept by the Organizer for a period of 10 years as required by applicable tax law during the contest. By registering and participating in the Contest, the Participants declare that they have read and accepted the privacy policy of the organizer where all the rights of the Participants regarding their personal data are detailed, respectively:

- the right to request the operator the access to them, rectification or deletion ("right to be forgotten") or restriction of processing;
- the right to oppose the processing;
- the right to data portability (to receive the data provided in a structured format and to transmit them to another operator);
- the right to withdraw your consent at any time, the processing of your data. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the legality of the processing performed on the basis of consent before its withdrawal;
- the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.

You can exercise any of these rights free of charge by sending a written request, signed and dated, to us by e-mail: contact@eu.rsystems.com. Upon receipt of the request we have the right to contact you to verify that you are the person who made the request (identity verification). If you refuse to process your personal data, you will no longer be able to be an active member of our community and your account will be deleted from our database and you will no longer be able to participate in R Systems Computaris contests, including this one. The organizer undertakes that personal data will not be disseminated to third parties.



The organizer also undertakes to comply with all the provisions of the European regulation on personal data protection, on the protection of personal data stored both during the contest and after its conclusion for an unlimited period of time and, if necessary, to notify the National Authority for the Supervision of Personal Data Processing, anything regarding the collections and processing of personal data carried out in connection with the registration and participation in the Contest.

Art. 12 Other clauses

The Organizer's decisions regarding the promotional campaign are final and applicable to all Participants. The prizes not awarded will remain in the possession of the Organizer who may dispose of them freely in the manner he deems necessary or appropriate to his interests.
